**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed Bids for design and construction of the Operations and Maintenance Support Building, addressed to Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority (Owner), will be received at the office of the Owner, 5513 Highway 162, Willows, California 95988, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on the 22nd day of September, 2017. Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

Bids will then be publicly opened and read.

The Project contemplated consists of the design (architectural and engineering) and construction of an Operations and Maintenance Support Building as part of the Fish Passage Improvement Project at the Red Bluff Diversion Dam.

The Work will be completed in all respects within 270 calendar days from the date when the Contract Times commence to run.

Bidding Documents may be examined in Owner's office, Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority, 5513 Highway 162, Willows, California 95988. Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Engineer's office, 2525 Airpark Drive, Redding, California, upon payment (check or money order only) of \$25.00 for each set of documents, unless otherwise noted. Return of the documents is not required, and amount paid for the documents is nonrefundable.

To obtain Bidding Documents via mail, send requests to the attention of Ms. Sarah Reindel, telephone (530) 229-3367, at the office of the Engineer, CH2M HILL, 2525 Airpark Drive, Redding, California 96001. Include check or money order in the amount noted above, plus \$10.00 for shipping.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form and accompanied by Bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish the additional bond(s) and insurance prescribed in the Bidding Documents.

In order to Bid and perform public work, the Bidder and Subcontractors shall hold or obtain such licenses as required by State Statutes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations. Bidders shall hold California Contractors' License, Class B at time of award. Failure to possess specified license at time of award shall render Bid nonresponsive.

The Work under these Bidding Documents is to be paid with Federal public funds; therefore, minimum prevailing wage rates published by the State and Federal governments, and for the location of the Project, are applicable. This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. All Contractors and Subcontractors who bid or work on a public works project, must register and pay an annual fee to Department of Industrial Relations. No Contractor or Subcontractor may be listed on a Bid

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proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

Payment for the Work accomplished will be made monthly, but part of amount earned will be withheld to ensure performance under the Contract. Substitution of securities for monies withheld is permitted by Contract Documents as an option open to Successful Bidder. For an appointment to visit the Site, contact Mr. Aaron Hall, TCCA, telephone: (530) 514-2796. A tour of the Site will be conducted as part of the prebid conference.

Attendance at a prebid conference will be a mandatory requirement of submitting a Bid for this Project. Refer to Instructions to Bidders for additional information.

Owner's right is reserved to reject all Bids or any Bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Bidding Documents.
