Rich Robertson reported on the following: Determination to utilize CVP Contract Section 3F, instead of 218 contracts, for future diversions of water during surplus conditions; conversations to occur between TCCA and USBR related to Section 3F pricing during surplus conditions; results of investigation of potential sites along the TC Canal (Orland area and Arbuckle Complex) for placement of DWR subsidence monitoring stations; status of Accelerated Transfer Program related to in-basin transfers during the 2024 Water Year and beyond.

Operations & Maintenance

A. Manager Sutton reported on the following O & M activities: TC and Corning Canal operations; Canal water quality treatments; erosion repairs; vegetation control; Willows compound building maintenance; facility

maintenance/repairs/painting/signage; FPIP maintenance; check structure maintenance; equipment repairs and maintenance; TC Canal O&M Bureau inspections; and safety meetings; upcoming invoicing on Warren Act Well test testing by USBR; and invoices for 2022 ACID O&M Deficit water transfer costs.

A. Manager Sutton reported on the relatively healthy status of CVP reservoir water levels as we start the 2024 Water Year; Winter Maintenance Shutdown activities beginning at the start of December, including dewatering of the canal for sediment removal in the Willows area and concrete repairs.

B. Manager Sutton highlighted some of the details of the proposed Draft 2024 TCCA Budget, Finance Committee will meet to provide recommendations on the Draft 2024 Budget in October, after which Manager Sutton will send out the Finance Committee's recommended Budget and present the same for consideration at the November Board Meeting.

C. Manager Sutton, assisted by Director Schaad, provided an overview of the Grant Application submittal to USBR for funding for Groundwater Monitoring. The Board discussed its support for all such proposals regarding groundwater monitoring, recharge activities and conjunctive use projects.
